This past summer, the Lord led me to establish the ministry into a non-profit organization. Since taking that step, God has put the desire in my heart to fulfill His call of evangelism and ministry full time.

Therefore, after fervent prayer and seeking guidance from the ministry's Board of Directors, as well as personal mentors; I am asking for you to prayerfully consider financially supporting the ministry of IRPG Mission.

After considering the cost incurred over the past years and researching a fair compensation, the Board of Directors has approved an \$80,000 budget for 2023. The budget includes; domestic mission trips to support the wildland fire community, Evening of Worship Services, membership dues, advertising, website, and traveling expenses.

IRPG Mission Purpose Statement

IRPG Mission is organized exclusively for charitable and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and is governed by a Board of Directors. The ministry of IRPG Mission focuses on three areas:

1. The ministry has a burden for the lost, therefore the ministry Preaches and shares the Gospel by fulfilling the Great Commission.
2. The ministry supports the local Church by strengthening Christians and exhorting them to continue to grow in their faith and relationship with Christ.
3. The ministry supports the Wildland Fire Community through domestic mission trips and sharing the Gospel message.

The mission is carried out by expository preaching of the Gospel, participating in and hosting revival services, hosting and organizing worship services, supporting the local churches by providing pulpit supply as well as other needs as requested.
